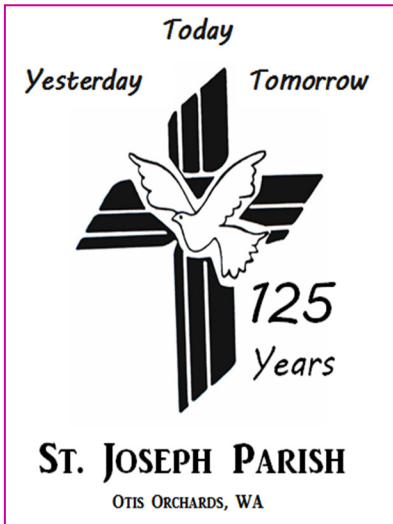

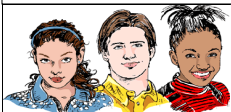

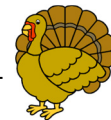
Are you thinking about becoming a Catholic?
