Dear Parishioners,

This year we have seen a dramatic drop in the enrollment and attendance at the Sunday Religious Education classes for PK – 7th grade students. *Parents and students, we truly miss you!*

Our faith family consists of everyone who is a member of St. Joseph Parish from Father Mike to the most recent newborn baptized into the Catholic faith and to the greater Catholic worldwide church. In baptism we promise to bring our children up in the faith of the Catholic Church. When you bring your child home for the first time you provide your child with food, clothing and, most importantly, love. By love and care they come to know that they are loved and are an important part of their family. Do they also know that they are an important part of an even greater family? God’s family here at St. Joseph’s? The Catholic family they were baptized into? We promise to ensure that they are an active member of our faith family, to know they are loved and an important part of their church family. Consider. If a member of our family does not interact with other members of the family they eventually drift away. The love is still there, the family still exists, but something is missing - unity, compassion, the ability to mesh with each other that makes the family unit whole, that makes it “one” and ensures its survival. The same is true with our faith family.

We need to show them not only how much God loves them, but also how important it is to be a part of His church family by providing them with every opportunity to be a part of this family.

For our children, the most important faith formation opportunity at the parish is our Religious Education Program.
